## Citigas Chief Says Producers Must Adjust to Market

New Mexico's small natural gas producers -- and that includes 85 percent of them -- may be out of business if they don't learn to operate in the deregulated market-place, said a denizen of that market-place. Roger B. Crawford, chairman of the board of Citigas Corp., said the shift from contract purchases to lower-priced, spot market purchases and new minimums set by end users may force small producers out of business. California end users, who traditionally bought 60 percent of New Mexico production, "still consider New Mexico gas one of the premium supplies because they're long-life reserves," Crawford said.

Citigas Corp. of Midland, Texas, was named a winner recently in a nationwide energy innovation search conducted by the Department of Energy. Citigas' entry in the National Awards Program for Energy Innovation is the patented Cool-Air Induction System (CAIS). The system improves the performance of natural gas fueled automotive-type engines up to 50 percent. In DOE tests, the system also reduced fuel costs by 22 to 47 percent.
